

# YAAK SCHOOL TECHNOLOGY LEVY

Some questions and answers

## **How much more tax will I pay?**

\$100,000 house	\$9.35 per year for 5 years
\$200,000 house	\$18.69
\$300,000 house	\$28.04
\$600,000 house	\$56.08

## **Why propose a Technology Levy?**

Costs are increasing and regular funding is inadequate. The Yaak School needs money to continue to provide secure internet, computers and software.

## **What would the money be used for?**

E rate discount decreased from 90% to 60%	\$3276/year
Infrastructure and website support	\$2255
CIPPA security filter	\$419
Software	\$1512
Laptop replacements 2 per year	\$1640
Printer replacements 2 printers amortized	\$120
Vibe board tablet 1 amortized	\$60
TOTAL	\$9282 / year

## **What if the levy does not pass?**

If the levy fails and the Yaak School cannot provide a technology program, the school will lose accreditation and be closed.

## **If the Yaak School closes there would be no elementary school tax at all. Right?**

WRONG. The Yaak School district would be annexed to the Troy district and Yaak property owners would pay tax to the Troy district.

## **How much would that be?**

In 2024 Troy property owners paid **3 TIMES** as much elementary school tax as Yaak property owners. If the Yaak School closes, your elementary school taxes would **TRIPLE**.

2024 Yaak elementary school tax	2024 Troy elementary school tax
\$100,000 house \$56.35	\$169.05
\$200,000 house \$112.70	\$338.10
\$300,000 house \$169.05	\$507.15
\$600,000 house \$338.10	\$1014.30
