Acceptable Use E-Policy

This policy applies to all electronic and digital equipment and services available at Yaak Elementary School. Use of school-provided computers, Internet, and other digital resources is a **privilege**, not a right.

Internet and Equipment Use Guidelines

- The Internet provides access to a vast amount of material, some of which may be considered controversial or inappropriate in a school setting.
- Yaak School has implemented content filters and monitors to reduce access to inappropriate content.
- During school hours, the teacher will guide and determine appropriate websites and applications.

Inappropriate Use

- Any use of school equipment or network deemed inappropriate by an administrator will result in **immediate removal of access privileges**.
- **Vandalism** of hardware, software, or data will lead to disciplinary action, which may include reimbursement for damages.

Distance Learning Considerations

- During distance learning, Yaak School cannot monitor, or filter Internet content accessed through home networks.
- **Parents/guardians are responsible** for supervising and ensuring safe use of digital devices while at home.
- The school cannot be held liable for inappropriate materials accessed outside of its network.
